

Waiver of Course Recommendation

Research shows that there are three major reasons for most student failures:

1. Poor Attendance
2. Level of difficulty is beyond the student's ability
3. Poor study habits and lack of follow through on homework

Students should maintain A or B averages and have a successful experience in the prerequisite courses before stepping to the next level of difficulty. Your student has not met this recommended level of success in order to receive faculty recommendation to continue or advance to the next level of difficulty. Statistics show that a large percentage of students who take a course not recommended by the prerequisite teacher make low grades. Please consider carefully. However, if you request that your student be placed in a particular subject, we will do that with the understanding that it will require principal permission to make a change of that course.

We ask that you talk with the teacher that is not giving the recommendation to be sure that you are aware of your student's work habits and abilities before requesting that the student take a course which may be too difficult. Our goal is that your student is able to succeed in the classes that they are taking at Providence Grove High School.
